## **BOMB SCARE AND STUDENTS' VACATION OF HALLS OF RESIDENCE**

The Governing Council and the Management of the University of Ibadan have noted with dismay and concern that a large number of students of the Institution have vacated their Halls of Residence following the postponement of the 2nd Semester Examinations and the unfounded rumour that bombs were to be detonated at strategic places on the campus as from 3.00 p.m. on Thursday 15 September, 2011.

Management had earlier allayed the fears of the members of the community that it was doing all that was possible, to safeguard lives and property on campus.

Management wishes to reiterate its earlier assurances and to further enjoin parents, guardians and the students to disregard these unfounded rumour. The examinations were postponed in view of the prevailing situation on campus (lack of electricity and water), an aftermath of the flood disaster of 26 August, 2011, which had since been rectified.

Examinations earlier postponed till Monday 19 September, 2011 will **hold** as already scheduled on the Faculty Timetable.

Students are further enjoined to ensure that they show up for the examinations as from **Monday, 19 September 2011**. Whoever does not show up will be solely responsible for his/her action.
