IMPROPER HANDLING OF FACILITIES IN THE HALLS OF RESIDENCE

The University Management has noticed with great concern the rather alarming rate of wanton destruction of plumbing works, woodwork and louvre blades in the Halls of Residence on the Campus. It will be recalled that quite recently, the University invested massively in the renovation of these buildings in order to enhance the living conditions of students and thus create a more conducive learning environment for them.

It is very disheartening, however, to note that this investment has totally gone down the drains due to improper handling of facilities in the hostels.

In order to stem the tide of these destructive tendencies, which invariably will cost the University much more in terms of repair, the University Management has decided that:

- (i) Registered students in each Hall of Residence will be surcharged for damages in such halls;
- (ii) Students who fail to pay for damages will not be cleared to register for academic activities in the following session;
- (iii) Students who harbour squatters will be ejected from the Halls of Residence as well as go through other sanctions following due process.
