## MANAGEMENT'S DECISIONS ON THE DISRUPTION OF JUMAT SERVICE OF FRIDAY, 13 AUGUST, 2010

Management at an emergency meeting held on Monday, 16 August, 2010 deliberated on the disruption of the Jumat Service on Friday, 13 August, 2010 and resolved as follows that:

➢ Miss Seun Olubunmi Adegunsoye (SI. 133066), a 400 Level student of the Faculty of Law remains suspended and should be brought before the Student Disciplinary Committee at the earliest opportunity;

➢ its earlier policy that preaching and all forms of religious activities should be restricted to designated areas of worship namely: churches and mosques; henceforth, religious activities remain banned in lecture halls, residential halls, buses, cabs, cafeteria, laboratories, common rooms and other public places outside the designated areas;

 $\succ$  the existing directive that there should be no lectures (formal or informal), examinations, practical or other forms of academic activities between 12 noon and 3.00 p.m. on Fridays is hereby reaffirmed.

Management appreciates the right of all members of the University Community to freedom of worship but calls on all to be moderate in all religious activities in order not to infringe on the fundamental rights of others. It further decided that:

 $\checkmark$  a list of all recognized and approved religious bodies on campus be compiled with immediate effect by the Student Affairs Division.

Management appeals strongly to all members of the University Community, irrespective of their religious affiliations, to allow peace and harmony to reign on the campus. Thank you.
