VICE-CHANCELLOR INAUGURATES COMMITTEES

In his determined efforts to fast-track meaningful development in the University, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. I.F. Adewole has constituted and inaugurated some committees with specific responsibilities.

Some of the committees include:

- (i) **Committee on Quality Assurance Policy** which is headed by Prof. G.O.S. Ekhaguare. The Committee is charged with the responsibility of formulating a Quality Assurance policy for the University.
- ii) **Committee on Students' Union Electoral Commission**, the team is being led by the Deputy Registrar (Student Affairs), Mr. T.I. Musa. This Committee is to ensure the smooth conduct of the Students' Union elections.
- iii) **Committee on Public Policy** - This committee is expected to critically analyze public policies and proffer solutions. It is also expected to transform over time, to the Centre for Policy Analysis and Development. It is headed by Prof. A. Ariyo of the Department of Economics.
- iv) **Committee on The West African Hub for the Earth and Life Sciences (ELS) of the Pan African University (PAU) of the African Union-** Headed by Prof. M.O. Abatan. It is saddled with the implementation of the ELS hub of the PAU.
- v) **Committee on UI Animal Production Venture** is being led by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic), Prof. I. Olayinka and saddled with the responsibility of resuscitating Animal Production in the University.
- vi) **Committee on the Actualization of UI School of Business-** the Chairman of this Committee is Prof. A.A. Ariyo with the core mandate of ensuring the successful implementation of the proposed UI School of Business.
- vii) **Task Force Team on Water Supply-** the team is headed by the Assistant Director of Works, Engr. F. Osibodu. The mandate of this Committee is to suggest effective and efficient means of supplying water to the University Community.
- viii) **Task Force Team on Energy.** This committee is to collate the energy needs of the University and spearhead the drive for energy sufficiency across the campus. The team is headed by the Director of Works and Maintenance, Engineer J.K. Ajibola.
