**1. STAFF MEDICAL SCREENING – REMINDER**

Management has directed that all members of staff should undergo medical screening to facilitate early detection, prompt treatment/follow up of diseases that are of public health importance in order to reduce the occurrence of sudden/preventable deaths amongst the University workforce.

The University Health Service in collaboration with the College of Medicine will be conducting the screening exercises for all members of staff of the University from Friday, 25 March to Thursday, 30 June, 2011.

The screening will be for Errors of Refraction, Diabetes Mellitus, Hypertension, Obesity, Hepatitis, Lipid Disorders, Cancers of the Prostate, Breast and Cervix.
