2. INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT RESEARCH CENTRE (IDRC) RESEARCH AWARDS

International Development Research Centre offers research awards annually to Canadians, permanent residents of Canada, and citizens of developing countries pursuing Master's or Doctoral studies at a recognized university or having completed a Master's or Doctoral programme at a recognized university. The awards aim to provide exposure to research for international development through a programme of training in research management and grant administration under the guidance of **IDRC** programme staff. They are designed to provide hands-on learning experiences in research programme management, and in creation, dissemination, and use of knowledge from an international perspective. These awards focus on research carried out in one or more developing countries.

Most research awards positions are for 12 months and are based at IDRC's Head Office in Ottawa, Canada. A few take place in one of IDRC's six Regional Offices. Starting in early 2012, the awards are normally held for 12 months. They are tenable, on a full time basis, for a minimum of 6 months and a minimum of 12 months. The programme is aimed at candidates who, through demonstrated achievements in academic studies, work or research, have shown interest in creating and using knowledge from an international perspective.
